

Gordon Seabright Volunteer of the Year Award

The Gordon Seabright Volunteer of the Year Award was established in 2014 by the Board of Directors of the VOCM Cares Foundation to commemorate the contribution of the late Gordon Seabright to the work of the VOCM Cares Foundation. The Award is intended to recognize a volunteer who has, through an outstanding effort, made an extraordinary contribution to his/her community and who has demonstrated community leadership through volunteerism.

This Volunteer Award offers an opportunity to recognize the outstanding individual who volunteers in their community and give so much of themselves for others.

The VOCM Cares Foundation will donate \$1,000 to a charity chosen by the recipient of the Gordon Seabright Volunteer of the Year Award.

The Award:

- A) The recognition of an individual who is an outstanding volunteer. He/she has contributed or is contributing to the development of the community by giving their volunteer time to organizations, groups and or discipline. The volunteer has gone above and beyond the call of duty and has provided exemplary service as a volunteer. The individual must have volunteered for a minimum of five years.
- B) The nominee must volunteer within the province of NL and provide a service to the people of NL.
- C) Absolutely no personal remuneration can be received for a service provided.
- D) The nominee must be nominated by a person or a group, and must have at least 2 letters of support from 2 different individuals. These letters should represent the outstanding commitment and service the nominee provided.

The Selection Committee:

- A) Nominations are received annually.
- B) A selection committee, appointed by the VOCM Cares Board of Directors, evaluates and selects the recipient each year.
- C) Any group wishing to re-submit or re-nominate a previously unsuccessful candidate can do so by providing an up-to-date resume for consideration.

Nomination Package needs to include the following:

- 1) Completed nomination form for the award;
- 2) Brief resume including: years of service and contributions to organization/responsibilities;
- 3) Letters of support (minimum of 2);
- 4) Please include approximately half a page to one full page of notes that could be read out at the presentation of the award;

All nominations must be submitted in writing by **Friday, March 24, 2017**.
